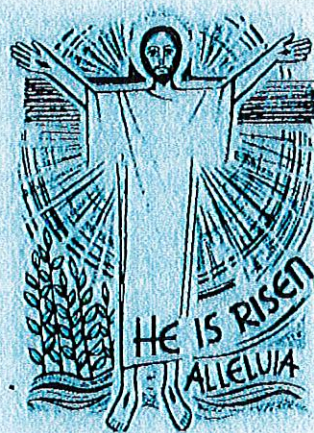
**Maundy Thursday** St Hugh's Confessions 7pm - 7.45pm, Mass of the Lord's Supper 8pm in both churches, followed by Watching
