English

Reading

In English we will be reading 'The Legend of Rock Paper Scissors' by Drew Daywalt and 'Escape to Pompeii' by Christina Balit which is linked to our history topic.

-Build fluency, comprehension and extend vocabulary skills.

Phonics/Spelling

We follow the 'Superhero Spelling Scheme' which includes the statutory key words for Y3/4, prefixes and suffixes and the study of homophones.

Grammar/Punctuation

We will be revisiting previous learning and the Y4 grammar content including: expanded noun phrases, conjunctions, adverbials, sentence types, tenses and apostrophes for plural possession.

Mathematics

Multiplication and Division B:

- Factor pairs
- Multiply and divide by 10 and 100
- Multiply and divide a 2-digit and 3-digit number by a 1 digit number

Length and perimeter:

- Measure in km and m (inc. equivalent lengths)
- Perimeter on a grid, of a rectangle and rectilinear shapes
- Find missing lengths and calculate perimeter of rectilinear shapes
- Perimeter of regular polygons and polygons

Fractions:

- Partition a mixed number, number lines with mixed numbers, compare and order mixed numbers
- Convert mixed numbers to improper fractions and vice versa.
- Add two or more fractions, add fractions and mixed numbers, subtract two fractions, subtract from whole amounts, subtract from mixed numbers

Decimals:

- Tenths as fractions and decimals and on a number line
- Divide a 1- or 2-digit number by 10
- Hundredths as fractions and decimals
- Divide a 1- or 2-digit number by 100

***Continually revise all multiplication and division facts (up to 12 times tables)**
