### English

#### **Reading**

In English we will be reading 'The Legend of Rock Paper Scissors' by Drew Daywalt and 'Escape to Pompeii' by Christina Balit which is linked to our history topic.

-Build fluency, comprehension and extend vocabulary skills.

#### **Phonics/Spelling**

We follow the 'Superhero Spelling Scheme' which includes the statutory key words for Y5/6, prefixes and suffixes and the study of homophones.

#### **Grammar/Punctuation**

We will be revisiting previous learning and the Y5 grammar content including: expanded noun phrases, conjunctions, adverbials, complex sentences (clauses), sentence types, tenses and apostrophes for plural possession.

-Descriptive writing - x2 contrasting setting descriptions  
-Explanation text about volcanoes

### Mathematics

#### **Multiplication and division B:**

- Multiply a 4-digit number by a 1-digit number
- Multiply a 2-, 3- or 4-digit number by a 2-digit number
- Divide a 4-digit number by a 1-digit number and divide with remainders

#### **Perimeter and area:**

- Perimeter of rectangles, rectilinear shapes and polygons.
- Area of rectangles and compound shapes
- Estimate area

#### **Fractions:**

-Equivalent fractions. Convert improper fractions and mixed numbers. Compare and order fractions less than and greater than 1. Add and subtract fractions. Add and subtract mixed numbers and subtract from a mixed number. Multiply a fraction and mixed number by an integer. Fraction of an amount. Find the whole.

#### **Decimals and percentages:**

- Equivalent fractions and decimals.
- Thousandths as fractions and decimals.
- Order and compare decimals up to 3 dp.
- Round to the nearest whole number or to 1 dp.
- Percentages as fractions and decimals.
